The new Wyndham Law Courts will be open from Monday, 10 November 2025.

Werribee Magistrates' Court will permanently close on Friday, 31 October.




The address of the new Wyndham Law Courts is **17 Basalt Road, Werribee**, next to Werribee Police Station.

The new Wyndham Law Courts building is the largest court complex outside Melbourne's central business district and will serve the Magistrates' Court of Victoria, the Children's Court of Victoria, and the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT).

The new building will have many features to improve the experience for court users including:

- comfortable waiting areas, courts, and hearing rooms with natural light and good acoustics
- separate entrances, waiting areas, and remote hearing facilities for increased user safety

- mobility access, hearing loops, accessible bathrooms, accessible parking, and a Changing Place accessible restroom for people with high support needs
- parents' rooms, child-friendly areas, quiet sensory rooms and a Sacred Space Prayer Room.
- bookable workspaces, interview and meeting rooms
- a Community Connections drop-in area providing access to a wide range of community services
- outdoor terraces with gardens and an external cafe





Getting there



Car: Free car and bicycle parking is available on site.



Train: The courts are approximately 2.2 km from both the Werribee and Hoppers Crossing Railway Stations.



Bus:

- From Werribee Railway Station, catch Route 170 or 153.
- From Hoppers Crossing Railway Station, catch Route 153.

Get off at the stops nearest the Derrimut Rd/ Princes Hwy intersection.

Arriving at Wyndham Law Courts

Arrive 30 minutes before your hearing time to enter through security screening. To find out where to go, consult the listing screens or kiosks in the foyer and follow the direction signs to your court or hearing room. Access is available via stairs and lifts.

Wyndham Law Courts are open between 8.30am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday. Service counters open at 9am.
